CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE

We release our Annual Report, a consistent practice that, while often featuring recurring elements, remains essential. Despite the familiar components, this year's report is no exception, mirroring the routine of previous years.

THYE HUA KWAN MORAL SOCIETY

The Thye Hua Kwan Moral Society (THKMS) marked its 44th anniversary in 2022, reflecting on a four-decade journey dedicated to upholding core principles centred on fostering respect for individuals of diverse race, colour, creed, and religion. Our committed team comprises employees representing a spectrum of race and religion, embodying the inclusive spirit integral to our organisational ethos.

THKMS has played a vital role in serving thousands of beneficiaries, providing halal food through our Meals-on-Wheels programme and supporting residents in our Homes. Additionally, we maintain an ongoing collaboration with grassroots initiatives in Sengkang, utilising our Temple to offer free tuition every Wednesday and Thursday evenings.

Our Temple, located at 71 Fernvale Link, is not just a place of worship, but a vibrant hub for building connections and spreading joy within the community. We have taken significant strides towards fostering a strong sense of community by organising and celebrating three festive events (Chap Goh Mei, Mid-Autumn



Festival and Chong Yang Festival) with our neighbourhood residents.

As we look ahead, our goal is to continue organising events that go beyond racial & religious boundaries, creating opportunities for peoople to interact, celebrate, and support one another.

Launched in July 2022, our new Super Talent student care facility within the temple addresses the pressing need for student care services in our community. Aimed at easing the shortage of available options, this initiative offers a safe and enriching environment for children. Our dedicated team provides personalised care and a range of educational activities to support holistic development. This collaborative effort reflects our commitment to the well-being and education of our young residents, filling a crucial gap in the community's support system. As we continue to grow, feedback from parents and the community will guide our efforts to create a valuable and integral resource for the educational journey of our children.

ANG MO KIO - THYE HUA KWAN HOSPITAL

2022 held special significance for Ang Mo Kio – Thye Hua Kwan Hospital (AMK - THKH), marking an important milestone in its two decades of unwavering commitment to our community. Since our establishment in 1993, AMK - THKH has accomplished numerous

milestones over these 20 distinguished years of service. From leading the establishment of isolation wards for Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome (SARS) patients during the 2003 outbreak to becoming the first community hospital to provide in-house dialysis services in 2013, our journey has been one of consistent growth and transformation.

As of 2022, our evolution from a modest 51-bedded hospital to a thriving 370-bedded community institution is a testament to our commitment. With one additional Dialysis Centre to serve the North region of Singapore, it reflects our dedication to meet the healthcare needs of our community.

AMK – THKH was honoured with the President's Certificate of Commendation (COVID-19) for exceptional efforts in Singapore's fight against COVID-19, along with the COVID-19 Resilience Medal. AMK - THKH was also awarded with a Certificate of Appreciation from HMI Institute. This recognition acknowledges the hospital's commitment and dedication to developing healthcare talents through annual clinical supervision for HMI students in therapy assistant training courses.

THYE HUA KWAN NURSING HOME @ HOUGANG

An exceptional moment of the year involved the acknowledgment of Thye Hua Kwan Nursing Home @ Hougang (THKNH) through the esteemed President's Certificate of Commendation (COVID-19). This recognition underscored the exceptional unity, resilience, and teamwork demonstrated by the THKNH team during challenging times.

With THKNH's CEO being honoured with the Public Service Medal (COVID-19), it served as a testament to the commitment and leadership that was instrumental in guiding THKNH through the complexities of the pandemic. It inspired us to continue our mission of delivering high-quality healthcare and making a positive impact on the community we serve.

THYE HUA KWAN MORAL CHARITIES

Thye Hua Kwan Moral Charities (THKMC) was incorporated on 13 October 2011 as a charity to provide multiple social and welfare services to the community at large and achieved an Institute of Public Character (IPC) status on 18 November 2011. Today, THKMC serves more than 70,000 beneficiaries through more than 70 programmes across five Services, which include Disability, Early Intervention for Children, Family, Seniors' Community, and Therapy.

As the nation recovers from the impact of COVID, 2022 was a year of awards and achievements for THKMC. THKMC received numerous accolades which amplify our mission in serving the various groups within the community. THKMC received the Charity Transparency Award for its credibility, excellent work and best practices. As a charity, THKMC focuses on ensuring good governance for accountability, building trust with stakeholders, and effectively managing its resources. It also received the bizSAFE3 certification, a milestone in highlighting the organisation's readiness in compliance, risk management and workplace safety.

THKMC received two Gold Community Care Excellence Awards (CCEA) in the Productivity Improvement and Clinical Improvement categories. This outstanding achievement demonstrates our commitment in delivering quality care and pivoting our services to meet the needs of our beneficiaries. Another highlight of the year was the launch of the THK Therapy Space @ Bukit Timah. The centre aims to make therapy services more accessible and convenient to nearby residents.

THKMC was a trailblazer in being recognised by the Ministry of Social and Family Development (MSF). THK Disability Services, THK Family Services @ Jurong and Ms Low Hwee San (Divisional Director, THK Early Intervention for Children Services) received the Friends of MSF Award, while THK Family Services Centre @ MacPherson received the MSF Community Cares Award. These awards inspire to drive social change and for others to do good for the community.

We've also partnered our community stakeholder by collaborating with South View Primary School in supporting children with developmental needs. The collaboration culminated with the Partner Award, for its contributions in knowledge sharing with the teachers through exchange programmes.



Established in June 2002, Angsana Home @Pelangi Village stands as a Welfare Home officially gazetted under the Destitute Persons Act. The Home functions more than just a shelter, and is dedicated in providing comprehensive care and rehabilitation services for destitute individuals. Operating alongside this, an Intake Centre serves as a crucial entry point for those seeking assistance.

Our mission extends beyond mere provision, as we are committed to crafting individualised care plans and implementing structured programs that facilitate the rehabilitation of destitute persons. The ultimate goal is their seamless reintegration into the community. Operating across the entirety of Singapore, Angsana Home @ Pelangi Village serves as a beacon of support, compassion, and transformative care for those in need.



In 2022, the Community Policing Unit (CPU) from Sengkang NPC began closer collaboration with Angsana Home. In addition to the routine visits to conduct focused talks to residents on topics such as scam-prevention, safe handling of personal property. the CPU officer actively supports in addressing criminal incidents involving residents. A specialised talk catered to our minority residents

took place, drawing attendance from 8 individuals. This session further reinforced the commitment to fostering a secure and informed community environment.



ONLINE GAMES & PERFORMANCE DAY

Students from Westwood Secondary School partnered with Angsana Home to organise a virtual session, titled "Online Games and Performance Day," held in August 2022. The primary objective was to educate and motivate residents to prioritise physical well-being through activities like simple exercises that could be done, even while seated.

Approximately 10 residents actively participated in this engaging session.

CONTINUITY PARTNERSHIP WITH YIO CHU KANG

THK MORAL WELFARE HOME

Moral Welfare Home, overseen by the Ministry of Social and Family Development (MSF) and managed by Thye Hua Kwan Moral Society, is a gazetted facility catering to destitute individuals who are wards of the state. Residents at the Home present diverse disabilities, with majority of them having intellectual disability.

Functions at Moral Welfare Home are operated by a dedicated Multi-Disciplinary Team comprising Case Management, Nursing, and Operations teams. The Case Management Team focuses on residents' biopsychosocial welfare, establishing connections with external resources, families, and the community. This team explores employment opportunities and assesses discharge potential to facilitate community reintegration.

As a gazetted Home, Moral Welfare Home undergoes monthly inspections conducted by a Board of Visitors (BOV), comprising industry experts engaged by MSF. These inspections ensure adherence to recommended standards and optimize residents' welfare. The Home prioritises post-surgical rehabilitation, updating individualised care plans through regular multi-disciplinary team meetings with MSF. A Board of Review Committee, made up of professionals, investigates and enhances the welfare and rehabilitation processes.

NEW INITIATIVES AND OUTINGS

As Singapore transitioned towards an endemic state and safety measures eased, the Home proactively organised many outings and activities for residents. These included movie outings, beach excursions, and educational tours, including a visit to Acres Wildlife Singapore. Additionally, the Home invested in new gaming devices to ensure residents remain engaged and entertained within the facility.






FOSTERING FAMILY BONDS

THK FREE MEDICAL SERVICES

THK Medical Services (THKMS) stands committed to providing medical assistance to all individuals in need, embodying an ethos that transcends race, colour, creed, language, culture, and religion. Through its dedicated efforts, THKMS extends medical services to the community through the operation of a free clinic.

Our commitment to community health is evident at our THK Traditional Chinese Medicine Medical Centre located at Taman Jurong by opening



its doors twice a week, ensuring accessibility and convenience for all. This reflects our dedication to fostering well-being and inclusivity, emphasising the significance of comprehensive medical care.

In response to the changing preferences of our community, we strive to enhance accessibility to Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM). In 2022, the hospital initiated One Rehab, a collaboration with various healthcare entities, aiming to facilitate seamless shared care across institutions and enhance decision-making from acute hospitals to community settings, encompassing the entirety of the care continuum. This initiative provides an end-to-end view of patients' rehabilitation journeys, contributing insights for service improvements and more effective policy formulation.

Thye Hua Kwan Nursing Home Limited (THKNH), a non-profit organization incorporated since 2013, plays a pivotal role in providing eldercare services in Singapore's Intermediate & Long Term Care (ILTC) Sector. Focused on financially challenged individuals, over 90% of our clients receive the highest government subsidy. Our client-centric approach aims to deliver integrated and seamless care for ageing clients and their caregivers across three business units: Nursing Home, Senior Care Centre, and Home Care Services.

Institutional Care at Thye Hua Kwan Nursing Home @ Hougang caters to 275 residents, including 114 with dementia. Emphasizing psychosocial, physical, medical, and emotional needs, we provide a tranquil, person-centred environment with innovative technology and dedicated dementia wards. Our goal is to create a comforting "Home away from Home" for residents.

Community Care at the THK Senior Care Centre @ Kaki Bukit offers centre-based care for up to 80 seniors during the day. Services include Maintenance Day Care, Dementia Day Care, and Rehabilitation with elder-friendly equipment, enhancing physical and social well-being.

THKNH Home Care Services extends holistic and person-centred care to elderly individuals in the community, with a focus on the needy and vulnerable.

Singapore Community Walk

Our nursing home residents and staff participated in the inaugural Singapore Community Walk on 1 October 2022, celebrating the International Day for Older Persons. We commend Ageing Asia for organizing the event and appreciate the opportunity work hand-in-hand with fellow care organisations.

THK Disability Services

Harvesting Greens, Planting Hope

THK Home for Disabled @ Sembawang collaborated with students from the Singapore University of Social Sciences (SUSS) to run activities with hydroponic systems to introduce horticulture to our residents. Horticulture enables our residents to develop their fine motor skills through packing, planting, harvesting and washing of planters. Through this partnership, SUSS students will gain a greater understanding of sustainable food supply, our community, and become advocates for the disability sector through their interactions with our residents. Harvested plants are distributed to the Sembawang community by our residents and the SUSS students as part of our community outreach.





Our Day Activity Centres also embarked on a horticulture programme to provide sensory play for our clients, as well as encourage interactions with volunteers from RSVP Singapore. As a result, our clients have learnt basic horticultural skills, and enjoyed the fruits of their labour. They harvested the green beans they planted and cooked them as part of their meals.

Empowering Our Clients through Knead with Love Bakery

Our Knead with Love Consultancy at **THK** Pan-Disability Centre @ Eunos is a social enterprise developed and supported by raiSE Reimagine. So far, 3 graduated trainees from our Knead with Love Bakery have successfully been placed under open employment.

In February 2023, our Knead with Love Bakery obtained the Singapore Food Agency Certification and is now halal certified.

THK Early Intervention for Children Services

Partners for Inclusive Practice (PIP) PIP started as a 1-year pilot to reach out and support inclusion in mainstream preschools and concluded in September 2022 with favourable results. The project involved an Early Intervention (EI) team who carried out support activities with 11 preschool teachers from 2 partner preschools – M.Y World Preschool and Super Talent Childcare. Many preschool teachers found PIP useful, and their confidence and skills in using inclusive strategies improved.

Waitlist Engagement – Building Blocks of Communication (WE-BBC) In February 2022, we launched the pilot of WE-BBC, a caregiver tele-coaching programme in which experienced El professionals use video-conferencing and recording to coach parents individually on improving their child's social communications skills through play, while they wait for a place in our EIPIC programme.

Findings showed that parents felt more confident in understanding and communicating with their children, and 83% of the children in the pilot improved their social communications skills. The pilot aims to run for two more cycles through June 2023, and has gained ECDA's interest in engaging families prior to enrolment, in view of the long national EIPIC waitlist.

THK Elderly and Home Care Services

Reimagining AACs

THKMC signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Agency for Integrated Care, SAGE Counselling Centre, and Tsao Foundation, and a Collaboration Agreement (CA) with Singapore General Hospital (SGH). Minister for Health, Mr Ong Ye Kung witnessed the MOU and CA signing ceremony held at **THK** AAC @ Beo Crescent on 19 August 2022. With this collaboration, residents and their families in the Beo Crescent community will benefit from greater support through a better integrated care system across health and social platforms.

THKMC thanked private sector partners such as IKEA, Google, and SymAsia-Yeo Family Foundation for the transformation of the Centre under the 'Re-imagining Active Ageing Centres' initiative, which provided enhanced facilities for our seniors to experience.





Engaging Seniors through Digitalisation

Accenture Singapore Health collaborated with **THK** AAC @ Toa Payoh 15 to conduct weekly engagement sessions for our seniors using digital games and devices. Through this initiative, the volunteers encouraged our seniors to engage in digital learning and fitness through technology. These weekly activities have helped our seniors overcome their technological barriers and demonstrate that exercise can be fun and easy. Through virtual games like bowling, sports and dancing, our seniors enjoyed learning to use digital gadgets while keeping active and healthy.

THK Family Services

- FAM@FSC (THK CFH Commonwealth) received National Association of Child Contact Centres (NACCC)'s re-accreditation.
- Principal Social Worker, Ben Ang Jingyou, from FSC @ Bedok North received the Family Violence Dialogue Group (FVDG) Appreciation Awards at the National Family Violence Networking System Conference in November 2022 from Ms Sun Xueling, Minister of State for Social and Family Development & Home Affairs
- THK Family Services received an Appreciation Award by the National University of Singapore (NUS) in November 2022 in recognition of the organisation's support to the NUS Social Work field education.
- Our Keluarga (OK) 7 community groupwork programme, which supports family members
 who have an affliction with drugs to stop the addiction, welcomed its eighth year with an
 active membership of 80 participants. The OK7 team also actively conducts sharings
 thrice annually to inmates in prison, as well as recruit inmates and their families into OK7
 as a form of sharing resources and to form a recovery support network to help them to
 lead healthy and better lives.

In line with MSF's Year of Celebrating SG Families, THK Family Services coincides this
campaign with National Parks Board's One Million Trees Movement with a Tree Planting
Event on 19 November 2022 at Fort Canning Park. Minister for Social and Family
Development, Mr Masagos Zulkifli graced the event and launched the tree planning event
alongside Executive Director (Nparks, Gardens & Nature Reserves) Dr Leong Chee
Chiew, THKMC Chairman Mr Chang Long Jong and CEO Mr Jason Lee.



THK Therapy Services

Creating Greater Accessibility to Therapy Services in Our Community

In April 2022, **THK** Therapy Services officially opened **THK** Therapy Space @ Bukit Timah, located within the Bukit Timah Community Club. The Opening Ceremony was officiated by Ms Sim Ann, advisor to Bukit Timah Grassroots Organisations. With the opening of **THK**MC's second Day Rehabilitation Centre, **THK** Therapy Space @ Bukit Timah enhances accessibility of therapy services to residents staying in and around the Bukit Timah area, especially for homebound seniors. The centre offers a full suite of services ranging from Physiotherapy to Occupational Therapy, and Speech Language Therapy. The centre also offers home therapy to bring the services to the doorstep of homebound seniors.



Reaching Out to Our Community

THK Children Therapy Centres (CTC) piloted the Preschool Screening Programme in September 2022, where complimentary speech and language screening for preschoolers were conducted across 5 preschools within the Queenstown Vicinity. Our Speech Language Therapists worked with the students to evaluate their risk of speech and/or language delay, and held 2 online Parent Talks covering developmental milestones, red flags for delayed development, and strategies to support speech and language development.

On 25 October 2022, **THK** CTC participated in CPS XPlains, a series of talks hosted by Child Protection Services, for Child Protection Officers (CPOs) managing individuals who may have developmental issues. The sharing, attended by 50 CPOs, provided **THK** CTC the opportunity to share the rehabilitation and support services offered by **THK** Therapy Services.
